**What happens next?**

Since the sperm must still meet an extremely high quality standard even after the freeze-thaw process, unfortunately only 5-8% of applicants are suitable as donors.

If your sample donation is suitable, this is followed by a blood sample and a urine sample to rule out infection. If these values are also in order, the contract can be concluded at a further appointment. The sperm donor contract clarifies the donor's legal status and regulates sperm donation, health checks and remuneration. After successful conclusion of the contract, regular donation activity begins.

Donation activity often takes place over 1-2 years up to 1-2 times a week. Please note that a sexual abstinence of 3-5 days must be observed for each donation (i.e. the last ejaculation must have occurred 3-5 days before), a urine sample from first-stream urine must be given before each donation and a blood sample must be taken after each donation.
