## Information on the collection of personal data - heterologous donors

At Berliner Samenbank GmbH (responsible: Dr. med. David J. Peet, Friedrichstraße 152, 10117 Berlin), all personal data is collected and stored in an EDP system. The collection, storage and processing of your data is necessary and permissible according to the European Data Protection Regulation (Art. 6 para. 1 b EU-DSGVO and Art. 9 para. 2 h EU-DSGVO). We are committed to handling your personal data with care. The data you entrust to us as part of your application to become a sperm donor and the suitability test will only be used by us to enable us to make the best possible offer to potential recipients or couples.

We do not pass on your personal data to third parties unless you have consented to such a data transfer or we are entitled or obliged to pass on data due to legal regulations and/or official or court orders (e.g. legally required blood and urine tests in external laboratories). To protect your data, appropriate contracts have been concluded with the service providers.

On the basis of the EU-DSGVO you have the right towards us

- to information about the data stored by us (Art. 15 DSGVO),
- to the correction of incorrect data (Art. 16 DSGVO),
- to insist on the deletion or blocking of your data (Art. 17 DSGVO) - if these are no longer required for the purpose of collection, storage and use, or if legal storage obligations, e.g. within the framework of the Sperm Donor Register Act (SaRegG) or patients' rights, or against the background of possible warranty or liability claims, no longer exist.

You also have the right to restriction of data processing (Art. 18 DSGVO), to data portability (Art. 20 DSGVO) and to object to data processing consent already given (Art. 21 DSGVO) with effect for the future.

If you do not agree with the collection and processing of your data, or if you suspect a violation of data protection law, please contact us.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Berlin State Commissioner for Data Protection (Art. 15 DSGVO):
